



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Must meet specific criteria for the scholarship to which students are applying for.
- Students must be currently enrolled at a HACU-member college or university at the time applications are completed and also when scholarships are awarded. Transferring students must transfer to a HACU-member to remain eligible to receive scholarship funds.
- Scholarships are only for current college students who completed their first semester. High School Students are NOT eligible to apply.

EXITO: CIA Career Exploration Boot-Camp

The Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (HACU) and the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) are partnering together to select up to 30 college freshmen to travel to Washington D.C. from May 30, 2023 to June 02, 2023 and participate in a three-day career exploration event. During the event, students will visit the CIA and meet with CIA professionals to learn about the culture, expectations, and opportunities available when pursuing a career with the CIA. The event will consist of informational workshops and networking activities. After the event, students will be encouraged to apply for CIA internships.

Eligibility Criteria:

- U.S. citizens
- Currently enrolled as an undergraduate **Freshman** or **Sophomore** at a HACU-Member Institution
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- **All Majors** are encouraged to apply
- Have excellent writing and briefing skills.
- Have an interest in serving as a civilian in the Intelligence Community
- Able to meet CIA suitability requirements and background investigation (character and conduct)

Award includes:

- Round-trip airfare to Washington D.C. (on May 30, 2023 to June 02, 2023)
- Hotel lodging for the duration of the event (3 nights)
- All meals during this event will be covered


